Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) Course (40 hours)

EMR Certification is required for all rookies who are not EMT's.

EMR Refresher Course (16 hours)

EMR Refresher is required for all returners who are not EMT's.

CPR Course- Blended Learning (2 hours online and 2 hours in person)

CPR recertification is required annually for ALL employees. Please contact Rob (REdgeron@BeachPatrolSC.org) to request access to the online portion. Once complete, coordinate with a supervisor to complete the in-person skills check-off. NREMT's may apply 4 hours of CEU's towards their 2-year recertification cycle.

Rescue Watercraft (RWC) Training (40 hours / 24 hours)

Rookies must attend 40 hours of RWC Training. Returners must attend 24 hours of recurring training annually.

Option 1:	March 11, 12, 13, 14	0800-1800hrs (10-hour days)
Option 2:	May 6, 7, 8, 9	0800-1800hrs (10-hour days)

Beach Emergency Vehicle Operations (BEVO) Training (24 hours / 16 hours)

Rookies must attend 24 hours of BEVO Training. Returners must attend 16 hours of recurring training annually.

NREMT's may apply 8 hours of CEU's towards their 2-year recertification cycle.
