

BEACH PATROL CANDIDATES

Lifeguard employment with Island Beach Services, LLC requires that those candidates-- in order that they are able to perform the duties of a beach patrol officer/lifeguard-- possess adequate vision, hearing acuity, physical ability and stamina as documented by a medical physician.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Duty as a Beach Patrol Officer/Lifeguard will include, but not be limited to, exposure to

1. Environmental conditions, sometimes extreme, i.e. sun, wind, salt, ocean currents and conditions, inclement and threatening weather;
2. Physical training to include, but not limited to, running, swimming, agilities and other activities of a highly physical nature;
3. Emergency, rescue, or first aid situations of a widely varied nature which could result in degrees of mental and physical stress;
4. Blood-borne pathogens exposure.

Your physician should complete the certification portion of this document. **You will be denied participation in any beach training until this documentation has been completed and returned.**
